

OUR ROOTS

- Alexander von Humboldt (1769 1859): explorer, universal genius, cosmopolitan and sponsor of excellent scientific talents
- **1953:** Establishment of today's Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, based in Bonn
- International network of academic trust and cooperation, modelled on Humboldt



WHAT WE DO


- Academic collaborations between excellent international and German researchers
- Various sponsorship opportunities
- International understanding, diplomacy, scientific progress and development
- Internationalization of Germany as a research location
- A network of more than 30,000 "Humboldtians" worldwide





OUR PRINCIPLES

- no quotas for countries or disciplines
- main selection criterion: the applicant's academic qualification
- we support people, not projects
- independent scientific research, bottom-up and investigator-driven
- flexible sponsorship options for different career stages and during the entire scientific career through Alumni sponsorship

For postdoctoral and experienced researchers

- researchers from all over the world
- all disciplines
- cooperation with an academic host in Germany
- innovative and independently developed research outline



Humboldt Research Fellowships for Research Stays in Germany

	Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
Duration of sponsorship	 6 to 24 months, may be divided up into 3 stays 	6 to 18 months, may be divided up into 3 stays
Application period	applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 4 years ago	applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 12 years ago
Fellowship amount	• 2,700 EUR per month (plus additional benefits)	• 3,200 EUR per month (plus additional benefits)






Application Requirements

Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers	
above average doctorate	• independent academic activity, e.g. as	
 academic publications 	an assistant professor	
 agreement by academic host 	comprehensive list of academic	
 independent research proposal 	publications with clear research profile	
 good German or English language skills 	agreement by academic host

Application Procedure

- online applications at any time to the Foundation
- assessment by independent peer reviewers
- decision by independent, interdisciplinary selection committees
- duration of procedure: approximately 4 to 7 months



Benefits Provided I

- monthly fellowship
- travel lump sum
- family allowances, childrearing support
- German language courses
- allowance for research costs for the host institute



Benefits Provided II

- intensive and individual mentoring in Germany by personal contacts at the Foundation
- study tour, network meeting, annual meeting
- alumni sponsorship
- Benefits for families (e.g. allowances for children and marital partners)






Humboldt Research Award

for internationally recognized topflight researchers

- award amount: 60.000 EUR
- only through nominations by Germany academics, no selfapplications
- invitation to Germany: approx.
 6 12 months
- worldwide, all disciplines, no quotas






Friedrich Wilhelm Bessel Research Awards

for internationally recognized researchers ("rising stars")


- Award amount: 45.000 EUR
- Only through nominations by German academics, no selfapplications
- Invitation to Germany: approx.
 6 12 months
- Worldwide, all disciplines, no quotas
- No more than 18 years after PhD






Hints and Tips

- take your time to find an adequate academic host
- choose the appropriate time to submit your application (PhD (almost) completed? Prior stays in Germany?)
- postdoctoral researchers: make sure that the key findings of your doctoral thesis are already published
- the research outline should not be a direct continuation of the doctoral thesis or of the academic work carried out to date
